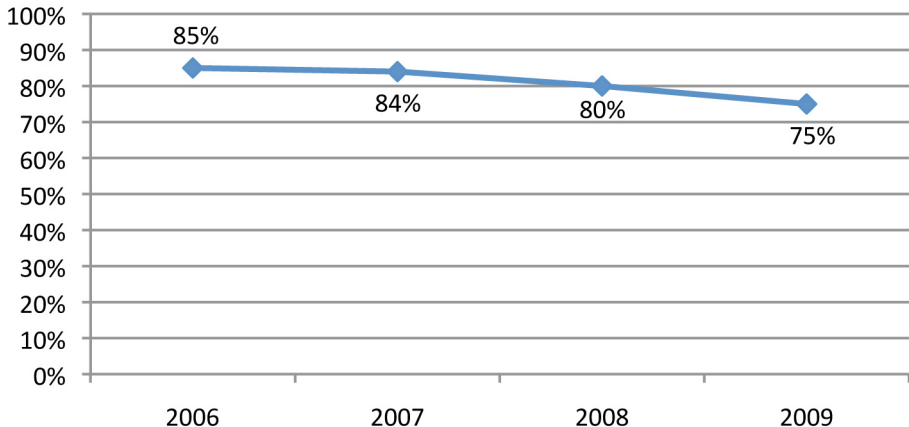
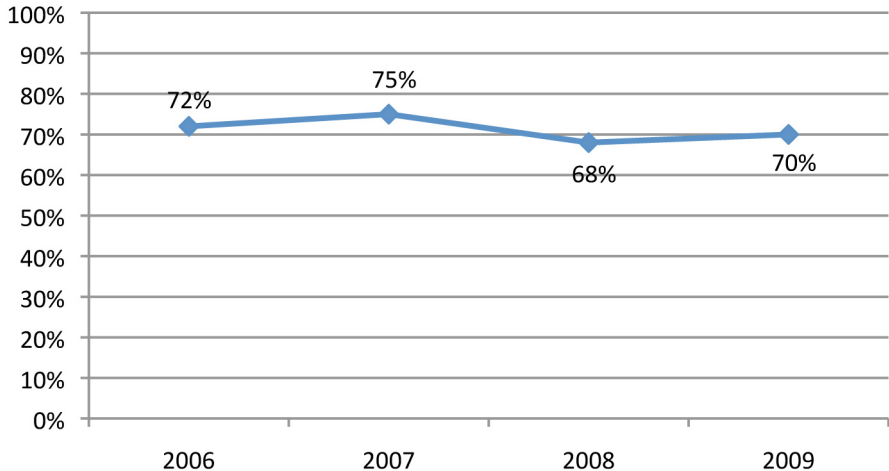


Respondents who believe that world's temperatures have probably been going up slowly over the past 100 years



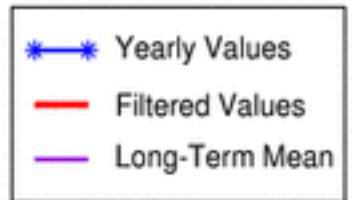
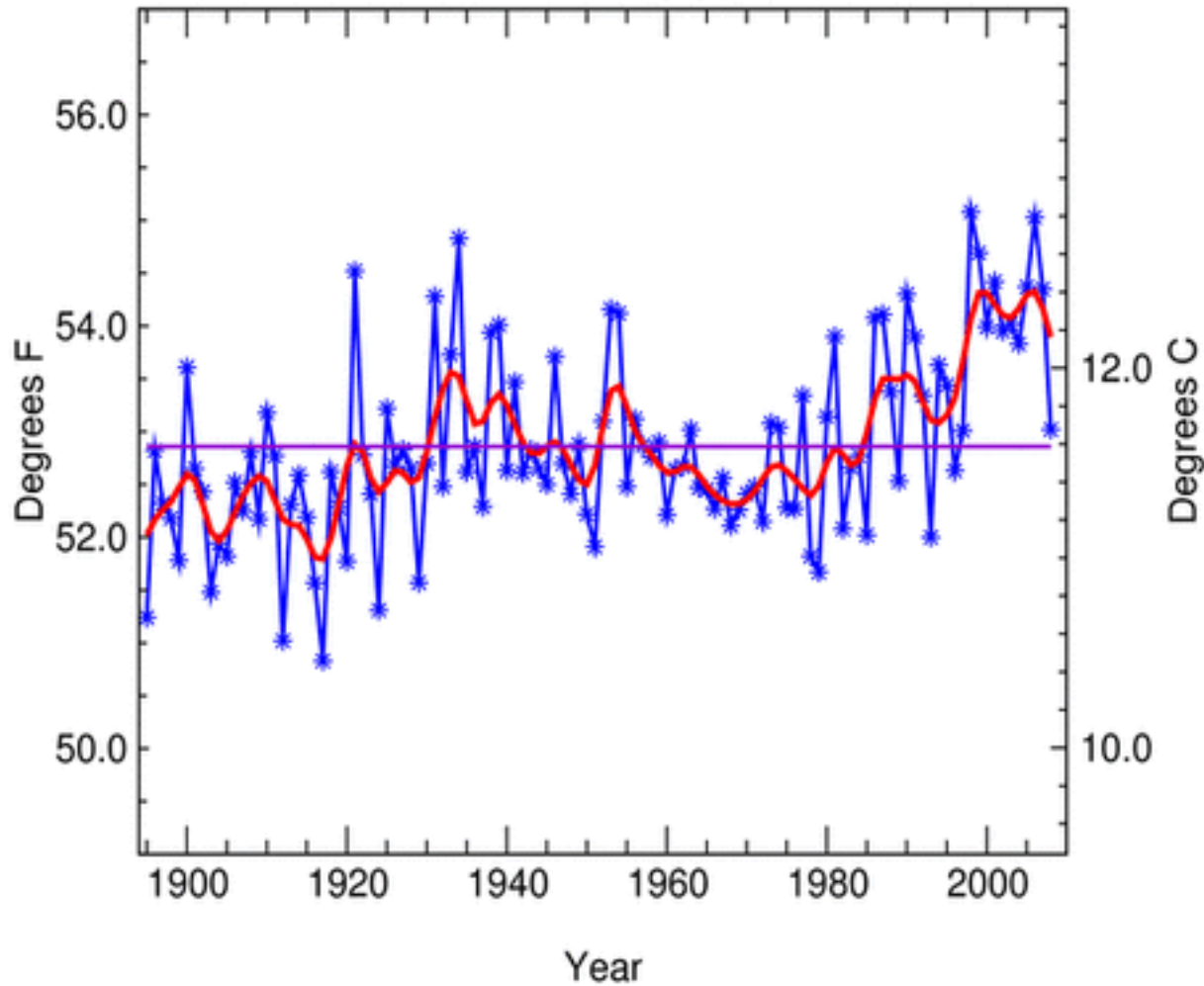

Respondents who trust scientists a lot or moderate amount



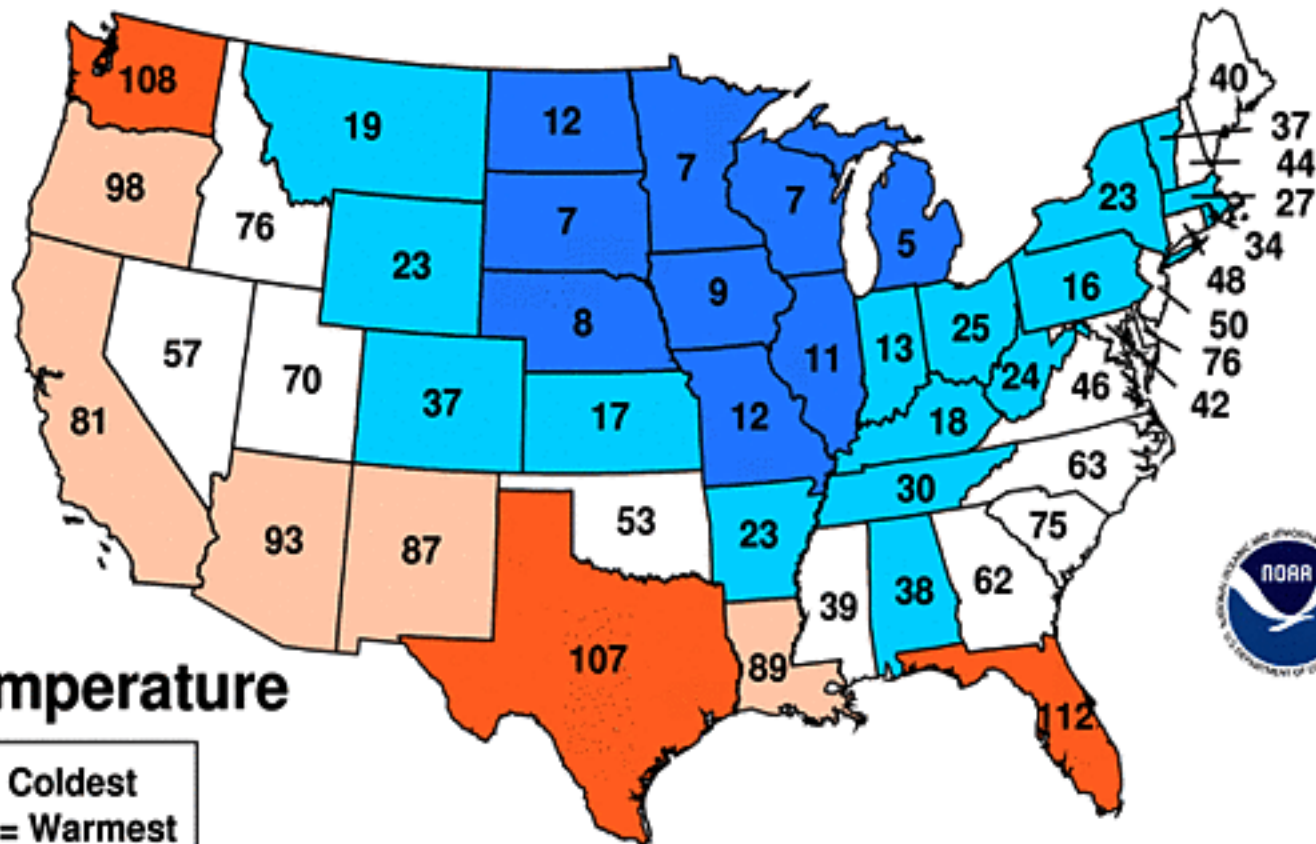

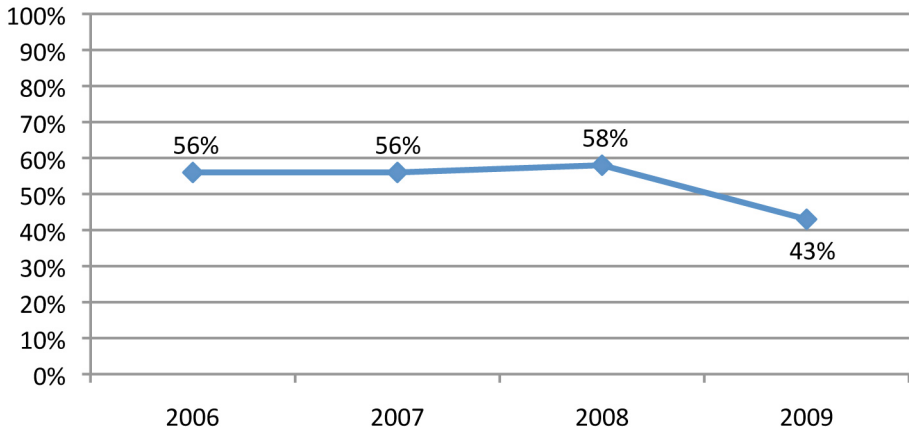

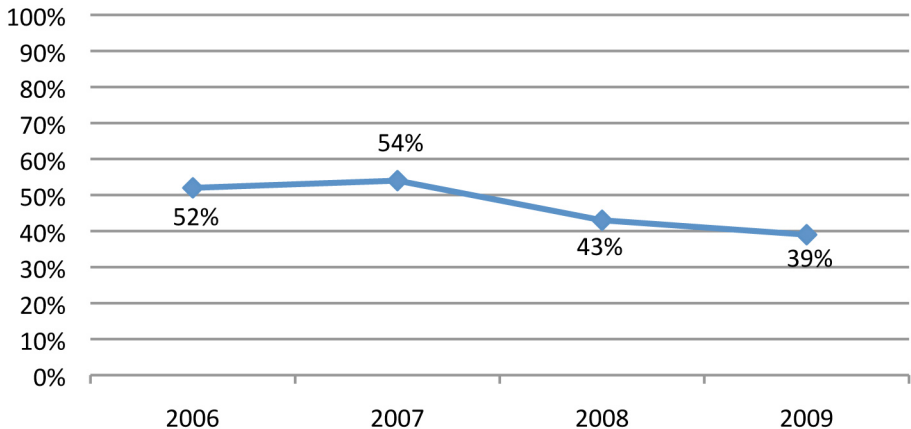

Respondents who say that average temperatures in the world have been higher in the last three years



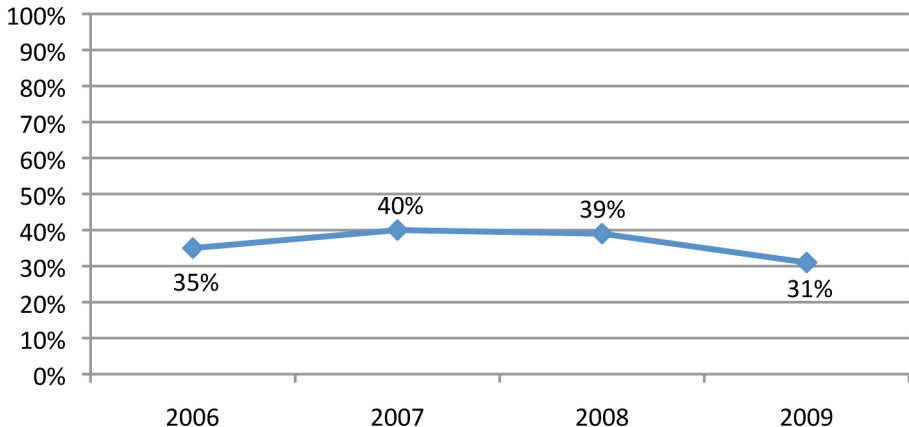
